

# Certified Wyoming State USBC Championship Tournament Rules

April 10&11, 17&18, 24&25 2010 (Additional weekend & Friday nights if needed)

**Added Scholarship 2,500.00**

1. Entrant must be a 2009-2010 sanctioned USBC member and sanctioned through local association prior to the start of this tournament or submit a letter of verification from the local secretary if membership is in progress.
2. AGES as of August 1, 2009 shall be used to class bowlers  
Class 3-----ages 11 and under      Team Event: consist of all boys, girls, or both  
Class 2-----ages 12 through 14      Doubles: Consist of all boys, girls, or both  
Class 1-----ages 15 and older      Singles: Consist of all boys, or girls  
Team consists of four members. Doubles consists of two members, All-Events: Boys & Girls per class. All classes shall bowl three games in each event. Combined groups shall bowl in the oldest age division. Entrants shall revert to their individual age class for singles and All-Events which separates the boys & girls.
3. Bowlers who bowl in the doubles event must also bowl in the singles event and vice-versa. Teams doubling together should send entries and fees in the same envelope. If you ask the Tournament Director to provide a bowler for either team or doubles. You must include the money for that bowler. Bowlers may enter only once in each event.
4. Averages used will be taken in the following order. (Also include Travel League if higher with **minimum of 12 games**).  
#1 Highest Wyoming USBC certified league averages as of December 31, 2009 minimum of 12 games  
#2 Highest Wyoming USBC certified league average as of December 31, 2009 minimum of 12 games  
#3 Highest Wyoming USBC certified league average as of February 1, 2010 minimum of 12 games
5. All averages must be verified by your local Association Secretary and/or Agent of USBC. December 31, 2009 averages (2009-2010 season) must be submitted by January 1, 2010 to the Wyoming State Tournament Director. Failure to comply will result in the entrant bowling scratch.
6. Entries must be post marked no later than March 12, 2010. No exceptions.
7. Falsification of any averages shall result in the automatic disqualification of bowler and /or team.
8. Handicap awards ratio shall be at least 1 to 10. All awards funds return is 100%. Awards will be given to the highest Scratch and Handicap- Team, Doubles, Singles and All-Events in each class. (Duplicated means- Ties for 2<sup>nd</sup> place; two 2<sup>nd</sup> places will be awarded and next award will be for 4<sup>th</sup> place)
9. All USBC Youth Tournament rules and regulation will be governed by USBC in any situation not covered herein.
10. No late frames shall be allowed. A bowler must start bowling in the frame he/she arrives, and receive no score for the frames not bowled. No blind score shall be allowed. A bowler must be ready to bowl when it is his/her turn, or receives a zero for the frames. In case of emergencies-tell the tournament director and scorekeeper.
11. Team and Doubles shall bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Subs must take the place of the bowler they are replacing. No rearranging of partners will be permitted. Subs may change the age class.
12. All entrants must report 30 minutes before assigned time. Any changes and/or subs are to be made at least ONE (1) hour before assigned squad time by the team captain or coach.
13. Handicap is 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 for each age class.
14. Entry fees are \$20.00 per event:  
\$14.00 Lineages/Expenses  
\$6.00 Awards  
\$20.00 Total entry fee (per person/per event)  
All events automatic if bowler bowls all three events, all bowlers are automatically in all Events providing all three events are Bowled.
15. After entries have been approved, any refund money will be up to the discretion of the tournament committee.
16. Any appeal or protest regarding scores or eligibility shall be made in writing to the Tournament Director.
17. Entry must be paid in full by cashier check, business check or money order. No Personal Checks.
