

## ***Wyoming “Scratch” Bowling Records***

**The variety and variations in the method by which handicap is calculated in league and tournament play prevents any degree of standardization of scores. Therefore;**

***Only scratch scores will be recognized.***

To be eligible to have your score(s) documented, the following requirements must be met:

To qualify for recognition all provisions of the USBC constitution, specification and rules must have been complied with at the time the score was bowled.

They must be bowled in the state of Wyoming in a USBC sanctioned event.

**“USBC Rule 51b Series Awards 3. Qualifications”** will apply to any event where more than 3 consecutive games are bowled.

To summarize this rule; when more than three, but less than six games are bowled in a series, only the first three games count for three game series awards. If six or more games are bowled in a series each succeeding set of three games, following the first three games, shall qualify as a separate series.

The categories to be honored are:

- 5 person team – Series & Game
- 4 person team – Series & Game
- 3 person team – Series & Game
- 2 person team (doubles)
- 3 game series (can be bowled as part of a team, doubles or singles competition – rule 51b applies to singles multiple game events)
- 9 games singles (all events)

All scores must be verified by state/local association personnel before submission to the WBA Association Manager or Statistician for consideration as a state record. Use the ***“Application for State “Scratch” Record”*** form to capture the necessary data/information.
